

AMY REEDER REINVENTS GEMWORLD WITH NEW AMETHYST SERIES

The first year of Wonder Comics' Young Justice reintroduced Gemworld and its most famous resident, Amethyst-propelling the character to a new six-issue Amethyst series from writer and artist Amy Reeder. While Reeder is a huge fan of the original Amethyst, Princess of Gemworld series and the '80s fantasy aesthetic, she's embracing a modern-day sensibility for an "entirely new" vision of Amethyst and the unique corner of the DC Universe she inhabits. We talked to Reeder about her plans for growing Amethyst by upending her status quo, and the psychedelic visuals she has planned along the way.

Your affection for Amethyst is clear—what is it about the character that you love so much?

Princess Amethyst and Gemworld embody all the best elements of children's fantasy from my childhood. I was born in 1980, and most of my all-time favorite cartoons came from that decade. There is something about the world-building-these fantastical worlds that felt old and new all at once-that became a part of me, influencing the way I dream and see beauty. I wanted to contribute to the world that helped form mine!

I also think it's really special that Amethyst and Gemworld exist within the DCU. We're talking female lead, fantasy, and an overabundance of purple. That is something I want to encourage and protect!

I love that the princess herself has ties to Earth. She represents us in this strange world, and we get to experience it with her. She's an earnest 16-year-old who wants to do the right thing-the real trick is, how do you know what's right?

Also, her name is Amy. How cool is that?

Readers have seen Amethyst in Young Justice as of late, but this is the first solo series for the character in years. How do you see her as uniquely meaningful today?

I love this question because it's exactly what sparked the whole plot. Amy has a "Little Miss Perfect" personality, and as a writer that's not always easy to work with, especially with readers looking for a little more meat. How do I write a story about a princess who already has everything figured out?

For me, it made sense to take the ground out from beneath her–and that starts out literally. She returns to the Amethyst realm and it's torn out, her people nowhere to be found. And in her quest for answers, she learns all sorts of other things that turn her world on its head.

For me, upending the status quo seemed like the best way for readers to realistically identify with someone who has that much power over others.

Exploring Gemworld looks to be a huge part of this. What can you share about your process in building the world?

Gemworld gives me so much to work with! Reading the original series by Dan Mishkin, Gary Cohn, and Ernie Colón, it's clear that almost anything goes, and I'm embracing that. This is a dreamland. It's divided up into 12 realms, all based on the birthstones–which I love. I'm giving each realm a different geography and a distinct look to each set of people. I have a fascination with landscapes and cultures, and with that I'm trying to create something that feels entirely new.

I've also done quite a bit of crystal research! Given that crystals are such a big trend these days, I thought it would be fun to amp up that angle, too. I'm paying attention to the patterns in raw crystal formation, and I've thrown a little bit of crystal healing in there, too. It is truly a gemobsessed book.

Gemworld is a vast and obviously colorful setting—what type of visual inspiration have you drawn from for this series?

Mostly, I'm just trying to keep my world quiet so I can listen to myself. I often have dreams with crazy visuals, and it's tough to remember it all, but I know I've got libraries of psychedelic stuff stored in my brain somewhere. I just try to trust that it's there and let it appear.

And that all stems from the visuals I loved from my childhood. If anything, I'd say I was inspired by *The Neverending Story* and *She-Ra, Return to Oz, The Secret of NIMH,* and *Unico in the Island of Magic,* too.

You've stated this series finds Amethyst "among the people." How important is that aspect to how you approach the series and its title character?

It's vital! Princess Amethyst is more accustomed to dealing with fellow (mostly adult) royals than she is with everyday people, but in this story, the royals turn on her. This forces her to deal with everyday people, but it turns out that slice-of-life Gernworld is actually pretty stunning. She gets to explore the world all over again, from a completely different angle.

I gave her two new teenage friends, and I think they'll be a major highlight of the book. I'm working to make sure they don't steal the spotlight too much, but it'll be the three of them, taking on the world, each one riding a ridiculous animal, because again: no rules! SPOTLIGHT

DC'S VILLAINS RISE IN *DCEASED: UNKILLABLES*

DCeased showed what happens when an outbreak turns the DC Universe's greatest heroes into bloodthirsty agents of deathand became one of the year's most popular comics in the process. Writer Tom Taylor returns to the ravaged world he built in DCeased: Unkillables, a three-issue companion series to the original story that tells the tale of what some of DC's greatest villains-headlined by Red Hood and Deathstroke-were up to when the Anti-Life Equation infected the planet.

DCeased stands as one of the biggest hits of 2019. Did the book's reception defy your expectations? From your perspective, what really resonated with fans?

I think the commercial success of *DCeased* caught a lot of people by surprise, and the reception was incredible, but from day one we knew we had something a bit special.

There was such a buzz generated online with the simple words "Darkseid Was," and then it just grew in momentum with more teasers and incredible art. Yasmine Putri's horror homage covers were just perfect, and an inspired call from editor Ben Abernathy. Francesco Mattina's "Faces of Death" covers grabbed everyone with undead clawed hands.

Did you always have a follow-up to DCeased *in mind? How did* Unkillables *develop?*

Definitely. I always planned for *DCeased* to be a larger thing, which is why we left so many villains out of our first story and set up a number of other things along the way. But I also wanted that first collection to stand strongly on its own. We hope that hardcover will sell forever.

We also couldn't push go on any more until we knew *DCeased* had a readership. I think it's safe to say we have a readership. Huge thanks to retailers and readers. Your support means we can bring more humor, Interview by Albert Ching

Karl Mostert will be a new name to a lot of fans. What makes him perfect for Unkillables?

As soon as we saw Karl's art, we knew he was the right artist for this horrific tale. Karl's art has this incredible frenetic energy that's perfect for *Unkillables*action-packed, chaotic fun.

Rex Lokus (who was so great on colors across our *Injustice 2* series) is a great fit for Karl, too.

There are a lot of fun villains at play here-how did the cast come together? What made Red Hood and Deathstroke the natural lead characters to navigate the DCeased landscape (er, what's left of it)?

They're both such great, uncompromising, ground-level characters, which gives us something vastly different to our first *DCeased*. This is the companion piece to the first, not a sequel. We saw death soaring through the skies and punching down buildings in our first take; now we get to see death stalk through the streets of Gotham City, we get to see the Anti-Living bounce off the Batmobile. We get to see how Vandal Savage, Lady Shiva, the Creeper, the Cheetah, Cassandra Cain, Deadshot, Rose Wilson, and more dealt with the apocalypse.

There is also a major threat hanging over this whole miniseries, and there will be some surprise characters showing their faces (regular faces and torn).





CONNER & PALMIOTI RETURN TO HARLEY OUINN, BRINGING THE BIRDS OF PREY WITH THEM

Amanda Conner and Jimmy Palmiotti's run co-writing Harley Quinn from 2013 to 2018 helped launch the antihero to new levels of popularity, and entrenched her as one of DC's most iconic characters. In February, the duo returns to Harley Quinn-and now she's got the Birds of Prey in tow. Conner is illustrating this four-issue tale as well as co-writing the series, and, for the first time, Harley is entering mature readers territory. Conner and Palmiotti detail just how far off the rails things will get in *Harley Quinn and the Birds of Prey*.

Let's start in the natural place: How much is this series a continuation from your previous Harley Quinn run? How does it feel to be returning to the character?

Jimmy Palmiotti: This book is a direct continuation of our last issue on the monthly *Harley Quinn* series. We pick up with Ivy and Harley having a bit of vacation time on a tropical island, and things go sideways from there.

Amanda and I are having a blast not only revisiting the supporting characters we established in the series, but also raising the stakes for Harley with the addition of the Birds of Prey and the Gotham City rogues gallery. We also have a lot of surprise guests we are putting in the book that fans of our work will totally be thrilled to see again.

And on the flip side of that-given that this is a mature readers series, what are you able to do in this book that you weren't able to before?

Palmiotti: Well, we are writing the book the way we see it and taking some things a bit too far, just to see how far we can go. We did that in the monthly series, and we had a boatload of red flags thrown at us all the time. We will be pushing every envelope we can to see where things land. Our main goal is just to tell the best story possible and get the readers involved.

Amanda Conner: That, and a few swear words. The challenge in the regular series was making up words and phrases that were not actually swear words. Sometimes, when we were on a roll, we made up words and phrases that sounded even worse than their original sweary counterparts.

Amanda, it's super exciting that you're illustrating this as well as cowriting. What lured you back to drawing interiors, and how much fun has it been?

Conner: I've always loved drawing interiors. I love the storytelling aspect, the pacing, the character actions and reactions. I didn't get much of a chance to do it on the *Harley Quinn* series, because I'm definitely not the fastest artist out there, and with co-writing and cover art duties, there was no way I would be able to keep up with a monthly book. Admittedly, I was extremely envious of Chad [Hardin] and John [Timms], but at the same time I was so pleased to have such fantastic artists on a book that we were writing. On this miniseries we've built in extra time so that I can get to do the interiors. I'm so happy to be able to do that on this book.

Of course, it's not just a Harley Quinn series, it's Harley Quinn and the Birds of Prey–what can you share about the dynamics of that ensemble, and how the rest of the team reacts to Harley?

Conner: Harley pretty much vexes all those around her. Even if you're a character that just loves her, she will exhaust you. It will be fun to see what kind of trouble she causes for the Birds, but we will also get to see which Bird vexes Harley.

We've also got The Joker and Poison Ivy involved, the two characters most closely associated with Harley. What are you looking forward to exploring in those relationships with this new series?

Conner: As far as Harley and The Joker go, it's always fun to watch what kind of friction two exes have with each other...it makes for really fascinating storytelling.

As far as Harley and Ivy go, well, it's like I said before...if you're a character that absolutely loves and adores Harley, she will still totally exhaust you.



JOE HILL AND STUART IMMONEN PLUNGE TO THE DEPTHS OF TERROR

Interview by Albert Ching

In *Plunge*, Hill House Comics mastermind Joe Hill teams with celebrated artist Stuart Immonen to tell the terrifying tale of the Derleth, whose crew miraculously returns after 40 years lost at sea-transformed by a mysterious infection, capable of stunning feats of mathematics, and stripped of nearly all their humanity. We talked with Hill for more on the fifth (and for now, final) miniseries from Hill House Comics.

What does it mean to have Stuart Immonen on board Plunge?

It's sort of hilarious, actually. I remember showing the pitch to Mark Doyle, my partner in grime at Hill House, and when he asked me what I wanted for art, replying, "I'd love if we could get someone who can draw a bit like Stuart Immonen. I've been imagining his style almost from the beainning."

And Mark replied, "Oh, uh, there's at least a chance I can get someone who draws a bit like Stuart Immonen..."

Stuart's ability to bring out the subtleties of character-in body language, in expression, in the tilt of the head-is second to none. His people feel real and relatable. In horror, identifying with the characters and coming to care about them is everything. Otherwise the scares just don't scare.

One of the strengths of Hill House Comics as a whole is how each book brings a different flavor of horror. How do you characterize the horror of Plunae?

We're going for something that has the feel of a certain kind of '80s sci-fi/horror: think of *The Thing* or *Aliens*. You've got a team of tough, affable, resilient professionals who are used to dealing with trouble... but who find themselves backed into a corner by something far beyond their experience, a chilling and otherworldly adversary. We want to build up that sense of claustrophobic danger and overwhelming menace, but we also want the reader to laugh with, root for, and care about the Carpenter brothers and Moriah Lamb.

How did the concept behind Plunge come together? Is it an idea that's been percolating for a while?

I was thinking about the sunken island of R'lyeh in the Lovecraft stories, and wondering what would happen if an oil crew sank a well there and started pumping up crude. The oil they'd be bringing up would actually be the ancient blood of elder gods.

And that is, actually, sort of the plot, although I'm skipping Lovecraft for my own, somewhat different mythos.

At the center of Plunge is the crew of the Derleth returning after 40 years–and coming back dramatically changed. What can you share about the state the crew is in upon arrival, and how it drives the mystery of the series? When we meet the crew of the *Derleth*, gone for four decades, they haven't aged a day. They've suffered from some terrible infection... their eyes are gone. But although blinded, all of them seem capable of incredible intellectual feats, and they share a kind of simple, glassy calm. They know things they can't know and can do things they shouldn't be able to do. Something is obviously terribly wrong with them, but sensing that isn't quite the same as proving it intellectually.

Plunge is the only Hill House Comics book set in the present. In what way does the series play on modern-day fears? It's also set in a very remote part of Alaska-how did you land on this location for the series? And how does that add to the horror?

It plays with the terror of infection, which is a timeless fear. It also explores our fear of the icy ocean depths, our sense of helplessness in the deep dark of the water, our awareness that there are things out there with teeth, and they could lunge out of the shadows at any moment.

The icy fathoms of the Arctic remain one of the least well-known places on Earth, and as Lovecraft noted, our fear of the unknown is the greatest fear of all.
